Virtual Fellowships

Virtual Fellowships allow cancer professionals from UICC member organisations to obtain expert learning and guidance in cancer control in English, French or Spanish, through a series of four one-to-one video calls with experts. This initiative complements the Technical Fellowships programme and will co-exist alongside it once it re-opens to provide an online alternative to UICC members.

Fellowship conditions and eligibility

Call timeframe	Open Call, from June 22 nd to December 31 st , 2020.
Target candidates	Cancer professionals working in research, public health or health service delivery at UICC member organisations.
Duration	One month: minimum of four weekly one-hour video calls.
Eligibility	Eligible candidates must be employed by a UICC member organisation (students are not eligible), have the endorsement of their line manager/superior and at least five years' experience working in cancer control.
Average value	No specific funding will be provided for those awarded a Virtual Fellowship.
Fellowship Topics	Depending on the level of interest, priority will be given to topics focusing on cancer control during the Covid-19 pandemic, including the challenges facing cancer prevention, screening, treatment, and patient support, although all applications in cancer control are welcome.
